WHEREAS

- the Institute published the Selection Notice "International Week – SAE Milan – Call Sept25"
- the aforementioned Selection Notice set forth specific evaluation criteria to be taken into consideration for the identification of the students to whom the allowance will be entrusted;
- the Selection Committee for the identification of the above-mentioned professional figure(s) was appointed by Francesco De Giorgio, Legal Representative of the Institute for the purposes of implementing the National Recovery and Resilience Plan project referred to herein;

NOW, THEREFORE

The Chairperson, Amanda Silvia Beghi acknowledges that a total of no. 29 applications for participation were received in the manner and within the time limits established.

The Committee, having verified the compliance and regularity of the submitted documentation, proceeds with the evaluation of the applications.

Below is a list of the applicants who submitted their expressions of interest and the respective scores awarded to each candidate.

This number will be used in place of the candidate's name in all public documents, rankings, and reports related to the selection process, thereby ensuring the anonymity and protection of personal data throughout the procedure.

The Committee has evaluated the candidates in accordance with the procedures outlined above and, for the reasons set forth in the preamble, hereby draws up the following ranking list:
